# **How does God get our attention?**

## *Intro to Chapter 7*

- **C – 1 → Overview of Revelation**
- **C's 2 & 3 → are present tense - a status report on 7 churches**
- **C – 4 → Future Tense – John to the throne room of God**
- **C – 5 → Focus – Scroll in God's hand – 7 seals**
- **C – 6 → 6/7 seals are opened – something bad happens**
- **C – 7 → Can any be saved – 2 groups**
- **Who can stand???**
  - **144,000 & Those saved from the Great Tribulation**
- **C – 8 → Back to destruction**

*C - 7 ended:*

**“These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. <sup>15</sup> Therefore, “they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will shelter them with his presence. <sup>16</sup> ‘Never again will they hunger; never again will they thirst. The sun will not beat down on them,’ nor any scorching heat. <sup>17</sup> For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; ‘he will lead them to springs of living water.’ ‘And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.’”**

1. *When the 7th seal was opened, what happened*

- **There was silence**
- **Almost like the calm before the storm**
- **Approx 1/2 hour**
- **Was this to get everyones attention?**
- **Silence also builds tension**

2. *What did John see?*

- **The 7 angels w/ 7 trumpets standing before God**
- **Jewish tradition → 7 angels guard the throne of God**
- **Trumpets were used to sound an alarm**
- **Silence will make the trumpet blasts even louder**

### 3. *What is said in Revelation verses 3-5?*

- **“<sup>3</sup> Another angel, who had a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense to offer, with the prayers of all God’s people, on the golden altar in front of the throne. <sup>4</sup> The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of God’s people, went up before God from the angel’s hand. <sup>5</sup> Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and hurled it on the earth; and there came peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning and an earthquake.”**
- **Another angel – w/ golden censor – offered incense to God**
- **Prayers of the saints mixed w/ incense offered up to God**
- **Are these prayers getting ready for Jesus’ return?**
- **Vs 5 wow! → Silence to rage**

The First Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“7 The first angel sounded his trumpet, and there came hail and fire mixed with blood, and it was hurled down on the earth. A third of the earth was burned up, a third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up.”**
- **Hail – fir – blood – hurled to earth**
- **1/3 of earth – trees & grass burned**
- **2/3 remain – terror aroused, but not totally destroyed**
- **Opportunity in the midst of doom**

The Second Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“The second angel sounded his trumpet, and something like a huge mountain, all ablaze, was thrown into the sea. A third of the sea turned into blood, a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.”**
- **Huge mountain – on fire & thrown into sea**
- **1/3<sup>rd</sup> of sea turned to blood**
- **1/3<sup>rd</sup> of sea creatures**
- **1/3<sup>rd</sup> of ships destroyed**
- **Again only 1/3<sup>rd</sup>**

The Third Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“The third angel sounded his trumpet, and a great star, blazing like a torch, fell from the sky on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water— the name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters turned bitter, and many people died from the waters that had become bitter.”**
- **Star fell from sky on 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of rivers**
- **Named “Wormwood” → bitter poisonous plant**
- **Sea is doomed**
- **Wormwood and gall – Jeremiah – given to idolators**

The Fourth Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“The fourth angel sounded his trumpet, and a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them turned dark. A third of the day was without light, and also a third of the night.”**
- **1/3<sup>rd</sup> of sun – moon – stars turned dark**
- **Darkness = sin**
- **Removal of light**

## The Interlude

- **“As I watched, I heard an eagle that was flying in midair call out in a loud voice: “Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels!”**
- **Eagle called out “Woe – Woe – Woe”**
- **Directed at earthlings**
- **Last 3 angels & trumpet blasts get even worse**
- **Represents the power of God**
- **Brings a warning to those not saved**
- **3 woes → emphasis → Take heed**

## The Fifth Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“The fifth angel sounded his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen from the sky to the earth. The star was given the key to the shaft of the Abyss. <sup>2</sup> When he opened the Abyss, smoke rose from it like the smoke from a gigantic furnace. The sun and sky were darkened by the smoke from the Abyss. <sup>3</sup> And out of the smoke locusts came down on the earth and were given power like that of scorpions of the earth. <sup>4</sup> They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any plant or tree, but only those people who did not have the seal of God on their foreheads. <sup>5</sup> They were not allowed to kill them but only to torture them for five months. And the agony they suffered was like that of the sting of a scorpion when it strikes. <sup>6</sup> During those days people will seek death but will not find it; they will long to die, but death will elude them. <sup>7</sup> The locusts looked like horses prepared for battle. On their heads they wore something like crowns of gold, and their faces resembled human faces. <sup>8</sup> Their hair was like women’s hair, and their teeth were like lions’ teeth. <sup>9</sup> They had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the thundering of many horses and chariots rushing into battle. <sup>10</sup> They had tails with stingers, like scorpions, and in their tails they had power to torment people for five months. <sup>11</sup> They had as king over them the angel of the Abyss, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon and in Greek is Apollyon (that is, Destroyer).”**
- **This star represents another angel – given a key to Abys – bottomless pit**
- **Locust came out of pit – only power to torment – not kill**
- **Do not hurt anything green – just those who do not have God’s seal on them**
- **Sound of chariots – cause emotional distress**

- **“The fifth angel sounded his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen from the sky to the earth. - Vs 7 – 10 description - locusts looked like horses...
- King over them – Apollyon – destroyer – Satan or his minion
- Torment – terror - frighten
- Is there still time to have a changed heart?

The Fifth Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“The first woe is past; two other woes are yet to come.”**
- **1<sup>st</sup> of 3 woes is passed**
- **Still the worst is to come**

## The Sixth Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“<sup>13</sup> The sixth angel sounded his trumpet, and I heard a voice coming from the four horns of the golden altar that is before God. <sup>14</sup> It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates.” <sup>15</sup> And the four angels who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind. <sup>16</sup> The number of the mounted troops was twice ten thousand times ten thousand. I heard their number. <sup>17</sup> The horses and riders I saw in my vision looked like this: Their breastplates were fiery red, dark blue, and yellow as sulfur. The heads of the horses resembled the heads of lions, and out of their mouths came fire, smoke and sulfur. <sup>18</sup> A third of mankind was killed by the three plagues of fire, smoke and sulfur that came out of their mouths. <sup>19</sup> The power of the horses was in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails were like snakes, having heads with which they inflict injury.”**
- **God told angel to release 4 angel who had been kept for this time**
- **Directed to kill 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of humanity**
- **200,000,000**
- **More the horses than the riders**
- **Fire – smoke – sulfur from horses’ mouth**

The Sixth Angel → what did the angel do and what happened ?

- **“<sup>13</sup> The sixth angel sounded his trumpet, and I heard a voice coming from the four horns of the golden altar that is before God. <sup>14</sup> It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates.” <sup>15</sup> And the four angels who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind. <sup>16</sup> The number of the mounted troops was twice ten thousand times ten thousand. I heard their number. <sup>17</sup> The horses and riders I saw in my vision looked like this: Their breastplates were fiery red, dark blue, and yellow as sulfur. - **Tails like snakes – inflict harm**
- **Is there still hope for the lost?**

11. What was said in Revelation 9. 20-21?

- **“ The rest of mankind who were not killed by these plagues still did not repent of the work of their hands; they did not stop worshiping demons, and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood—idols that cannot see or hear or walk. Nor did they repent of their murders, their magic arts, their sexual immorality or their thefts.”**
- **Conclusion to 3 chapters -**
- **Jesus said in Luke 16. 31**
  - **“If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.”**
- **Are we to violate their free will?**
- **What does it take to get someone to believe?**
