"16 When all Israel saw that the king refused to listen to them, they answered the king: "What share do we have in David, what part in Jesse's son? To your tents, Israel! Look after your own house, David!" So the Israelites went home. <sup>17</sup> But as for the Israelites who were living in the towns of Judah, Rehoboam still ruled over them."

 Solomon's decisions affected Jeroboam and Jeroboams decisions led to a split in the nation

- David
- Solomon

#### Solomon had 2 Sons

■ Rehoboam → from tribe of Judah

- Jeroboam → from the tribe of Ephraim
- 1 Kings 11 says that a prophet went to Jeroboam and told him that he would be king – to wait – he didn't – he rebelled against Solomon

When Solomon divided his heart between the gods of his wives and concubines — he set in place this division in the people of Israel

Our actions — our sins have consequences that are far reaching and will affect those around us

- 2. 1 Kings 11. 9-13 says God became angry with Solomon Why?
- He had many wives/concubines
- He allowed them to turn him from God
- He built altars to these gods
- He sacrificed to these gods

- 3. Who was Jeroboam why/how did he rebel against Solomon?
- One of Solomon's trusted men
- An Ephraimite from Zeredah
- Mother was a widow Zeruah
- A man of standing in charge of Solomon's laborers
- Alijah the prophet vs 29ff
- The first King of Israel's divided kingdom
- Created idols
- Ruled 21 years
- Name = "he who opposes the people"
- Did evil before The Lord

#### 4. Who was Rehoboam & what is said of him?

- Son of Solomon
- 1<sup>st</sup> King of Judah
- Continued Solomon's hard policies
- Name = "who sets the people at liberty"
- Did evil before The Lord

#### 6. What did the Man of God proclaim?

- P 196
- 1 Kings 13. 1-3
- A son Josiah will be born to house of David
- He will sacrifice priests who sacrifice to idols

#### 7. What is the story concerning Abijah?

- He was Jeroboam's son
- He became sick
- Jeroboam sent wife disguised to seek Ahijah the prophets help
- Ahijah was blind
- God told him what was to happen
- 1 Kings 14. 6-11

#### 8. Who is Shishak & what did he do?

- 1 kings 14. 25ff
- King of Egypt
- Attacked Jerusalem
- 5<sup>th</sup> year of Rehoboam's reign
- Carried off temple & royal palace treasures
- Even Solomon's gold shields
- Rehoboam replaced them with bronze shields

- 9. Who was Asa & what is said of him?
- In Jeroboam's 20<sup>th</sup> year —Asa became King of Judah
- Reigned 41 years
- He did what was right in the eyes of the Lord
- 1 Kings 15 11ff

#### 10. Who was Ahab & what is said of him?

- 1 kings 16. 29ff
- 38<sup>th</sup> year of Asa's reign Ahab became King of Israel
- Reigned in Samaria
- Reigned 22 years
- Did more evil in the eyes of the Lord than all before
- Married Jezebel
- Served Baal
- Set up altars to Baal
